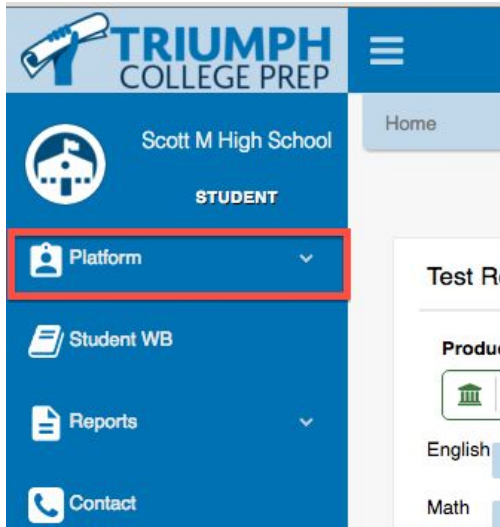
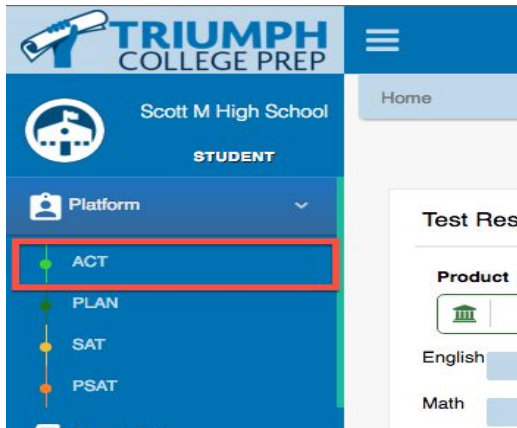


## Instructions for students taking ACT Online Test 002.

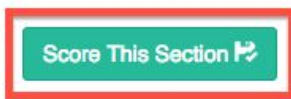

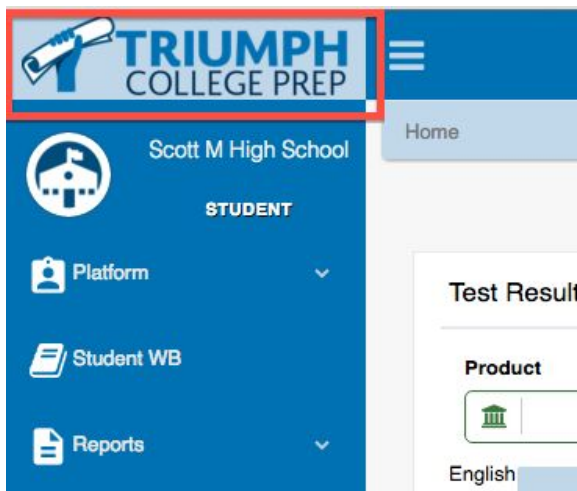


Students will repeat this process for all four sections of the Test. When complete, their test score will show in the grid.
